Attorney Marevious Allen addressed the council about the progress with the annexation of the following unincorporated properties Mallet Lane, Mac Lane, and HWY 160 North. After he gathers all the information and gets the approval from the citizens located on the properties then he will be able to start the annexation process. He also informed the council that once those properties are annexed the city will then be able to provide city services to the citizens located on the properties.
