EXCESSIVE FORCE RESOLUTION

A resolution establishing rules and regulations regarding the use of excessive force during nonviolent civil rights demonstrations, including physically barring entrance to a facility or location which is the subject of such demonstrations, and providing penalties for violations thereof in the following City of Ames, County of Liberty, State of Texas, as follows:

ARTICLE I

Section 1

It is the policy of the City of Ames to prohibit the use of excessive force by the law enforcement agencies within its jurisdiction against any individual engaged in non-violent civil rights demonstrations. The city/county also prohibits the physical barring of any entrance to, or exit from, such a facility within its jurisdiction.

ARTICLE II

Section 1

It is the policy of the City to enforce this policy to the full extent allowed by law.
